The structure was designed as a duplex home totaling 10,063 sf, with both units featuring master suites, secondary bedrooms, laundry, kitchen, great room, dining, and outdoor patios and roof decks. The units are separated by a large concrete demising wall 30 feet tall and 12 inches thick.

The forms of the structure take on a modern design with cubes that stack and cantilever, or levitating, from the structure. Views of the West Vail Valley can be enjoyed from most rooms of each unit.


The larger of the two homes is nestled into the sloping hillside and features a partially subterranean bonus room and two bedrooms that look out on custom graffiti selected by the client. The master suite of the larger unit was established as one of the signature pieces of the home, cantilevering 12 feet from the main structure and creating a covered loggia adjacent to the great room below. The master bedroom reaches toward the hillside and immerses the owners into the seasons that define the Rockies.

Situated on a hill looking out to the harbor and up to the main street to the west, the cottages draw their inspiration from both the workers' cottages and the grander homes of the district. They represent an appropriate, but extremely creative solution to the challenge of situating a multi-unit project in an historic neighborhood of single-family cottages.

Added to the intrinsic efficiency of compact units, and a relatively high density, the inclusion of two units deed-restricted to people with low and moderate incomes ensures this is affordable to many. The most prominent theme of the site design

are the grand steps that lead up to the shared courtyard. These steps solve the grade issue while providing a fitting and impressive address on Castle Street for this pocket neighborhood.

Contrasted with the monumental scale of the steps is the intimate scale of the cottages and the courtyard they share. The outdoor kitchen, gathering spaces, and front porches of the highly efficient homes make a place where neighborliness is not taken for granted.

Built on the site of a former church in the Bronx, this LEED Gold, 112-unit building is a mix of supportive and affordable housing. The design was inspired by the notion that a house of worship is a beacon of light in its community. From that idea came 12 floors of large, fully glazed elevator lobbies, which provide spectacular views by day and become a glowing tower at night.

Rock formations uncovered during construction were incorporated into the landscape, providing a visual association with the park and a connection to the area's natural environment. They also supply an organic complement to the straight lines and right angles of the building.

Decking extends out over the rocks to a lookout point, where the topography slopes downward toward the west, revealing more views. The bell and stones from the original church, placed throughout the landscaping, celebrate the site's history. The resiliency and sustainability measures, quality building materials, shared views of the city, evening light for the community, and elements tying to the property's past, exemplify the inclusivity and care that underlies this work.


When the architects saw a stately hay barn with a "for-sale" sign, they knew they would save it by making it their home. Their design goals were clear; the exterior would respect the original Dutch gambrel design. Therefore, the original vent and door openings were used for entry, window, and dormer locations.

On the interior, it was important to express the impressive, two-story volume of the barn, to keep the existing structural elements, and to reuse and repurpose any materials removed. Posts and beams were used as focal points. Original cedar siding was preserved and reused as the base of the kitchen island, an accent wall in the powder room, and as the material for sliding barn doors.

For sustainability, solar panels are utilized across the western roof. Motorized blinds control solar gain in summer and allow solar warming in winter. Nearly all systems are automated in the house: heat /air, fans, lights, and lamps are all programmed to come on when needed and to turn off when appropriate.

With nearly 7,000 square feet of transparent planar architecture, In Plane Sight encapsulates — by a horizontal bridge-like architectural form — 180 degree views of Paradise Valley, Camelback Mountain, the city of Phoenix, and its surrounding mountain ranges. The client program was straightforward: modern and view-capturing with equal parts indoor and outdoor living spaces.

A glass entry door provides a glimpse of a private bridge connecting the master suite to outdoor living, highlights the vista beyond, and creates a sense of hovering above a descending landscape, turning the 45-foot elevation change on the lot into a captivating advantage. Indoor living spaces enveloped by pocketing glass doors open to an outdoor, three-level paradise.


The raised peninsula pool, which seemingly levitates above the ground floor plane, becomes a centerpiece for the outdoor living environment and the connection point between lower-level entertainment spaces (home theater and bar) and upper outdoor spaces (living, kitchen).



Boasting true mid-century modern architecture, this 1967 home was purchased by a well-traveled family that loves globally inspired style and clean lines. Their goal was to keep the feel of the home but add an international flair not commonly seen in Michigan.

The main living space was generous but needed to be opened so that the kitchen was not hidden behind a wall in the dining area. The wall was removed and skylights were added to complement the existing windows above the cabinetry. Frameless, flat-panel cabinets in a white matte finish were installed around the perimeter to further the airy feel of the space.

The walnut kitchen island, coffee bar cabinets, and floating shelves added a natural element in keeping with iconic mid-century modern style. The full slab backsplash, waterfall island countertop, and paneled refrigerator contributed to the clean lines of the large space.

The Harbor Island Residence is a traditional home located on a private island within Newport Harbor. The home's three stories are celebrated at the foyer with nearly 30 feet of volume. The staircase bookends the entry, as well as conceals the wine storage and corking area. Adjacent to the foyer is the executive office suite.

The main living space consists of a bar, lounge, great room, dining and kitchen in an open plan married with Old World detailing and finishes. The second level contains the master suite, three secondary bedroom suites, laundry, gym. The third-levelentertainment space houses a bonus room and bar, and opens to a rooftop deck.

Extensive exterior detailing complements the stone finishes and is capped by a mixture of natural slate and zinc roofing. See additional images for this project on page 39.

A thorough site analysis and collaboration between the client, architect, interior designer, landscape architect, and builder resulted in a unique home. It is balances deftly on the site, showcases the views, respects the neighborhood, and is custom fashioned to fit the family. Outside, a steel-and-precast concrete bridge over the front garden connects the street to the entry; the roof deck perched above the garden provides expansive views of Mount Rainier.

Inside, a steel, glass and wood stair is contained within a tower of light. In the kitchen, light floods through clerestory windows; an outdoor room provides a true year-round space seamlessly connected to the kitchen.

The careful balance of scale, proportion, and color creates an intimate and casual feeling beneath the soaring ceiling in the living room, which features a three-sided fireplace and entertainment center. The gym, which opens onto the garden patio through massive sliding doors, features wood siding salvaged from the original home.

The project site was a city parking lot, and the city required the developer to give back 234 public parking spaces within the development. The objective was to create a vibrant live/work/ play community in a four-story, mixed-use structure with the second level at street grade, allowing retail bays to face the sidewalk to encourage pedestrian engagement. Exterior done was in a vibrant contemporary industrial style to reflect the area's heritage with rich character and detail at street level to energize street engagement.

The project includes three major murals and sculptures to emphasize the community's commitment to public art and improving the quality of life. Two floors of rental housing are lifted above the street on top of parking structure; units face the front street or overlook a private 18,000 sf elevated pool courtyard with resident club facility on the third level. Project connectivity leverages proximity to Pinellas Trail, a 38-mile public trail/park system, with walking paths and a dog park connecting to the walking trail.

Bell Heights, named for the reuse of the 1959 Southwestern Bell switching station and Telephone Museum, is a 44-unit development surrounded by restaurants, retail and antique stores. Twenty-four luxury lofts were created from the conversion of the historic building, with an additional 20 freestanding cottages on the 1.6 acre property. All residents are able to enjoy the fitness room and 10,000 sf rooftop terrace, complete with summer kitchen, fire pit, sundeck, plunge pool, putting green and unobstructed views of Houston's downtown skyline.

The old brick building was originally constructed with a basement with 12-foot ceilings. The developer saw the opportunity to install a ramp and convert this basement into a 50- car parking garage that provided two car spaces and extra storage for every loft unit, plus bike storage.

Each loft unit is beautifully designed and includes features such as 12-foot exposed concrete ceilings, brick-wrapped columns, floor-to-ceiling windows, balconies, custom cabinetry, and more.

Combining history, context, and culture, Anaha is an extraordinary example of contemporary place-making. The tower begins the implementation of Ward Village, the nation's largest LEED-ND master plan. The 40-story tower creates 318 condominium homes that helped to transform the previously industrial district into a 24-hour, mixed-use community.

The tower's undulating form is inspired by the island's artistic tradition of abstracting waves. Through a sequence of interlocking and curved floor plates and a high-performance glass curtain wall, the façade appears to be ever-changing in the light, like a wave shimmering in the sun, to produce a distinctive and dynamic addition to the coastline.

The orientation of the tower's long axis is placed mauka-makai (mountain-side/ocean-side), preserving coastal views from inland vantage points. The tower is brought down to the street to mark the residential entrance. The podium's retail and townhomes activate Kamakee Street.

Between the tower and podium geometries, a water feature is framed by a living wall, which passes through the lobby façade. Perched 80 feet above Auahi Street, a glass-bottomed pool cantilevers 15 feet off the edge of the amenity deck, creating a memorable spectacle.



Surrounded by floor-to-ceiling glass and Jatoba wood, the first-floor design focuses the eye on created beauty, including a suspended hanging wall with a ceramic art installation, a cantilevered staircase, and a custom children's play stage that doubles as storage. The living, dining, and kitchen areas subvert traditional distinctions between interior and exterior space through use of retractable glass walls.

each separated by generous dog trots, and all under one butterfly roof. The roof design simplifies the capture of rain water, and expands views across the ranch and lake under a deep porch eave. It also captures prevailing west breezes, funneling them into the outdoor areas and dog

The home features more outdoor living area than it has air-conditioned space. Deep eaves, well considered spaces on various parts of the architecture, huge operable screens, and consideration of wind patterns make these spaces comfortable for year-round use, allowing for less conditioned space in the build.

Material selections were influenced by both the local landscape and the client's Brazilian heritage. The home is fully elevated, but it is rooted by columnar elements of clay brick and elevated planters of exposed concrete. In the guest rooms, bookshelves were built from a slab of reclaimed Guanacast (Brazilian tree), recovered locally following Hurricane Irma.

It is the most energy efficient home in Florida, and among the most energy-efficient homes ever built. It has a HERS index of minus 31 and is certified Emerald by NGBS.

The Haven at National Harbor marks a transition from the commercial core at the district's Potomac River waterfront to the bordering single-family neighborhood. The condo community occupies three city blocks, reinforcing the urban streetscape and scale.

Its 248 units surround a central open space, creating an exclusive resident experience removed from the surrounding boulevards and traffic. Views of the district's iconic skyline and National Harbor's Capital Wheel Ferris Wheel are available from many of the building's units and common spaces.



The 19-story high-rise tower consists of 765 beds in 257 furnished residential units. The ground level includes 10,783 sf of commercial space designed to provide street-level transparency, engage pedestrians, and promote walkability.

Premium indoor amenities totaling 12,153 sf include a clubhouse, fitness center, and study lounges. Cascading outdoor terraces with sweeping views exceed the city's usable open space requirement and provide ample opportunities for social gathering. The elevated rooftop amenities, totaling 40,467 sf, maximize sun exposure and consist of a resort-style swimming pool, mini putting green, firepitm and barbecue areas.

The design concept seamlessly blends two buildings and two structural systems — precast and cast-in-place concrete frame — to create one cohesive project. The contrast in materiality results in compelling exterior façades. Large carve-outs throughout the building's skin reveal contrasting color and texture hidden behind the outer face, allowing the design team to introduce shifts in form, strong shadow lines, and unique unit layouts.



Focusing on the owner's desire for an open, lightfilled space, the design-build team transformed the 1950's maze of existing rooms and hallways into a spacious home suitable for entertaining, while respecting the scale of the original structure and the aesthetics of the historic neighborhood. A standing seam roof was installed, with handturned ridges, just as those original to the area.

Interior walls were relocated and ceilings were raised. Four new skylights, including one above the master shower, flood the home with natural light and warmth. The covered patio and outdoor kitchen enable year-round hosting. The private patio off the master bath features an outdoor shower and private courtyard. The walk-in closet, utility and butler's pantry provide ample storage. An antique maple butcher-block was integrated into custom cabinetry, which was styled to be functional and efficient while maintaining this historic element.

The Quartermaster Dock House and Dock, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, was built in the early 1900s to serve as a drop-off point for military personnel, supplies, and artillery. When it became available in 2013, it was nearly falling into the creek. It was important to the clients that the restored dock house remain true to its roots.

The structure had to be carefully relocated by barge to install a new foundation. Being suspended over water, a waterproof flooring system was designed to deflect saltwater wave action from below. The team collaborated with



a structural engineer to reinforce the building envelope to comply with current wind codes.

The existing footprint for window and door locations was used to maintain the historic integrity from the exterior. The only addition was an overhead garage-style door, providing an unobstructed connection to the creek and breeze. The interiors, however, were designed with an entirely new purpose.

This nearly 100-year-old New England cottage was reimagined to create an inviting, comfortable, and environmentally conscious net-zero home. Design and construction goals were complex and multi-faceted. Beyond incorporating game-changing technology to make the home net-zero, the renovation doubled the home's s footprint with a 1,000-sf addition; introduced a contemporary, open floor plan; resolved asbestos and environmental issues; and restored the charm that had been lost after two mid-century renovations.

While doubling the home in size, and introducing a 6KW solar array, the home remained harmonious



in form, material, siting, and scale with the surrounding neighborhood. The renovated home combines traditional shingle-style architecture and state-of-the-art technologies including photovoltaic solar panels, an advanced heat-recovery HVAC system, advanced air sealing and insulation, EnergyStar appliances, triple-glazed argon-filled Low E windows, and LED lighting.

The outside wall of the kitchen was bumped out by 4 feet, and the family room wall was removed to open the two spaces, creating a better flow. This allowed access into the banquette in the center of the kitchen. The banquette is bordered on two sides by counters and cabinets, as well as stool space. Opposite the seating is a wet bar, pantry, and serving counters. Waterfall countertops complement the client's modern take on a glamorous kitchen.

This Spanish Colonial Revival style senior housing solution combines life's necessities, conveniences, and luxuries under one roof by

utilizing site conditions and building orientation. Sustainability, aesthetics, and accessibility define triangular design of the all-inclusive building with interconnecting fins to create a holistic community for memory care, assisted, and independent living.

Memory care with associated dining, gathering, and activity area assures safety of the residents through a dedicated sunken courtyard encompassing the spaces with a retaining wall on the hillside. Assisted and independent living spaces are located on the upper floors, between first and fourth-floor common areas. Common area spaces are designed to stimulate five senses of

the residents, based on wellness atmosphere principles.

Amenities including a commercial kitchen, bakery and bistro, movie theaters, grandkids game room with play area, an art studio including pottery kiln, and raised hydroponic community garden with green house add to the resident experience. Arched arcades and courtyards with fireplaces and cabanas provide shaded exterior gathering areas. The stucco exterior is punctuated by gray inset medallions, dark wood corbels, rafter tails, shutters and trims. Clay roof tiles with mud stops adds to the authentic design elements

The state-of-the-art, 8,900-sf clubhouse at Seven Desert Mountain is a stunning sculpture of steel, stone, masonry, and pocketing glass. Heated patio floors, 40-foot cantilevered hemlock overhangs with evaporative cooling, indoor-outdoor dining and bar areas, five fire pits, two fireplaces, and two bocce courts create a family-friendly community gathering place.

Hefty stone tablets were constructed using locally sourced field stone and antique-style grout, exposing aggregates within and providing an aged-in-place sense to the modernist building. To create a complementary material hierarchy and with the goal of appearing layered rather than modular, masonry head joints were brushed and bed joints were tooled. Warmly hued concrete floors, rich wood paneling, zinc countertops, and leather-wrapped handsets provide consistent elements of natural materials.

Creating designs that capture the indoor/ outdoor lifestyle on Anna Maria Island can be daunting; with tight lot sizes and strict zoning requirements, the task requires vision. The home concept immediately began with a modern design aesthetic to make the best use of natural light and sweeping bay views.



The goal was to create spaces that capture the views of Tampa Bay and to use the flat roof line as an opportunity for more leisure space on a roof top deck. Although the family agreed that the modern layout captured the views and maximized outdoor living spaces, they were concerned that the modern aesthetic would be "too cold" for their taste. The kitchen was designed with that statement in mind.

To maintain a more casual modern feel, the designer used standard shaker cabinets in a deep blue. The floors are a driftwood color to help bring a coastal organic feel to the space. Wood tone and gold accents are also highlighted through the kitchen to give a warmth that complements the modern waterfall island.



The dramatic centerpiece of the lobby of 465 North Park space is a sculptural plaster-and-terrazzo circular staircase, measuring 15 feet tall and 14 feet in diameter, that rises up to the mezzanine level. Featuring guardrail walls with a custom plaster finish that also wraps the underside of the form, the stair's stark white color and smooth, seamless surface complements the interior finishes of the lobby while echoing the elegance and movement of the overall building form.

The stair walls are detailed with recessed metal handrail and LED lighting that runs the entire length of the staircase. Additionally, the stair treads and risers are made of field-fabricated, custom finish terrazzo, poured and formed in place. The successful execution of the technically complex design was achieved through extensive coordination with the architect, interior designer, structural engineer, steel fabricator, light gauge subcontractor, and multiple finish subcontractors.

The orchid conservatory, designed as a zen mediation space for the owner, features four walls of trellises to display orchids, an outdoor shower, lovely seating area, gates on both sides,

and a relaxing bronze Cupid fountain that can be heard from the tub in the master bath. With ample space, orchids can be planted in floor pots or hung from the substantial lattice structures with oval portholes.

The space steps down into a beautiful courtyard in the front of the home, enhancing its calming effect. Fragrant, flowering plumeria trees nestle the structure tightly, providing a stunning backdrop of color. The subtle sound of the fountain completes the bath for the senses.

What had once been a cow pasture just north of Tampa is now home to the nation's first Crystal Lagoon by Metro Lagoon. The man-made, sustainable, crystal clear body of water serves as the epicenter of the Epperson community, allowing for swimming, paddle boarding, kayaking, and walking around sandy beaches. It also offers a swim-up bar, cabanas, floating obstacle course,

and more — minutes from doorsteps — making this the ultimate residential experience. Spanning 7.5 acres, the lagoon is 4,200 linear square feet in circumference, with an average depth of 8 feet and with some areas as deep as 12 feet.

Crystal Lagoon's advanced ultrasound technology system uses thousands of sensors to keep the water crystal clear. It uses 50 times less water than a park of the same size and 30 times less water than an 18-hole golf course. It uses 100 times less chemicals than a swimming pool and up to 50 times less energy than conventional pool filtration systems.

The introduction of Metro Lagoons will forever change how residents view coastal living in Florida. Instead of having to drive an hour to the beach, it is just steps from their front doors, regardless of location.
